Online Check In: Alaska Airlines

Everyone SHOULD check in online beginning at 11:35AM on Friday, February 16th. Note, you will **not** be able to look up your flight information until this 24-hour period prior to departure begins. Since we are booked as a group reservation, you may not be able to check in online. DO NOT WORRY! You still have a seat and there will be plenty of time to check in when you arrive at the airport.

Meeting at Airport: Saturday, February 17, 2018 - Arrive 9:15AM at Alaska Airlines

Please meet at the ticketing area dedicated to group travel to be directed by SAA staff to most efficient line. The group area is located to the right after exiting Sky Bridge 4 and heading straight up to the departures level or to the right after entering from Door #25 (See Attached Map- meeting location highlighted in blue). After checking your bag at the counter, meet with your team in the designated group area. DO NOT go through security until you have met up with your team and received your trip t-shirts. Your ENTIRE team will go through security together once everyone is accounted for. Keep in mind; flying Alaska may require you to jump on the airport tram to your gate, which may be located in the "N" Concourse.
