# **New Orleans Trip- Packing List**

## Luggage

- Maximum of 1 carry on & 1 checked bag. All items (incl. pillow) **must** fit in these two bags
- Most airlines charge \$25 for 1<sup>st</sup> checked bag <u>EACH WAY</u> (don't forget \$25 for return flight!)
  - Note: cash/check generally not accepted as form of payment at airline counters. If student does not have a debit/credit card, some families purchase a prepaid VISA gift card with \$50 to cover cost of checked bag both ways.

### Clothing (check the weather before packing!)

- Volunteer Clothes (5 workdays)
  - Sturdy, thick soled, closed toe shoes ideally hiking/work boots (sneakers okay)
  - **Comfortable clothes** you don't mind getting dirty (enough for 5 days)
  - Required: (1) lightweight long sleeve shirt in case building task requires it
  - <u>Required:</u> (1) pair of **long pants** in case building task requires it
  - Hat or bandana & sunglasses
  - Water bottle
- After Workday/Non-Workday Clothes (7 days)
  - Comfortable walking shoes
  - **Casual clothing** for 5-6 days some days we will wear work clothes to activity
  - Waterproof Jacket
  - Sweatshirt/Fleece for layering
  - Pajamas (sometimes AC can be cold at night)
  - Undergarments & Socks
  - **One** (1) **outfit for church service** on Sunday

#### **Personal Items**

- Bedding \*SAA will provide a blanket for each participant
  - Sheet(s) for twin mattress
  - Pillow
- Towel
- Shower Shoes
- Toiletries (toothbrush/paste, deodorant, shower supplies, etc.)
- Medication/Prescriptions (if applicable)
- Sunscreen/Insect Repellent
- \$125 (suggested) Spending Money for a few meals out with team and souvenirs

#### **Notes & Suggestions**

- There is <u>no access</u> to laundry so please pack enough to last the entire trip.
- Pack a garbage sack to pack work clothes home in. Work clothes get very dirty. Some people also decide to throw them away at end of week.
- \*\*We recommend those with dietary restrictions pack snacks and/or be prepared to purchase snacks to supplement their meals while in New Orleans.
