



New Orleans Area Habitat for Humanity is excited to welcome Shirts Across America volunteers to New Orleans! We hope you find these step-by-step instructions on how to register in our volunteer portal helpful.

1. Visit our volunteer calendar/registration portal: www.noahhvolunteer.org.



2. Just below the instruction block and above the first section (General Construction), please select 'NEW VOLUNTEER REGISTRATION' (third selection).



3. Fill out the login information registration section as outlined below.
 - a. * signifies a required field.
 - b. Create your own login name (we recommend you use your email address as your login) and create a password (your password must be at least 6 characters long).
 - c. Choose a security question and provide your answer.




Description: Hard-working local families partner with NOAHH to become homebuyers with a 0% interest mortgage and a monthly payment of no more than 30% of their income. They provide 250 hours of sweat equity in place of a down payment by building Habitat homes or working at one of NOAHH's ReStores. All FTHP families must show a need for housing, the ability to repay a mortgage, and the willingness to partner with NOAHH. In addition to their contribution of sweat equity hours, homebuyers take financial literacy classes, home maintenance training and save a minimum of \$2,500 towards their escrow account. Since our inception, NOAHH has built and sold 635 single-family homes and 77 rental units. Over the past three years alone, NOAHH homebuyers have paid over \$1,250,000 in property taxes in Orleans Parish.






