

## New Orleans, LA (NOLA) - Immersion Trips

General Information for Mid-Winter Break

This information is provided as a guide and is based on previous Shirts Across America (SAA) immersion trips. Please note this information is subject to change for each trip.

**Trip Update:** SAA remains committed to providing a safe environment for all. This limits

the number of volunteers we can take on each of our 2024 trips. Certain SAA building partners may require volunteers to take certain health precautions

prior to their visit to New Orleans.

**Dates:** Mid-Winter Break Trip

Saturday, February 17 - Saturday, February 24, 2024

(All 2024 trips are sponsored by and overseen by Shirts Across America)

**Building in NOLA:** Shirt Across America (SAA) has a volunteer trip to New Orleans available for

Mid-Winter Break. SAA is focused on building homes and building leaders as we work with our partners' Habitat for Humanity, Youth Rebuilding New Orleans, and SBP to build homes in the New Orleans area. SAA has sent over 4,400 volunteers to work on 225 homes/projects in the Gulf Coast since 2008.

SAA volunteers will work in several unique neighborhoods in the greater New Orleans region. Therefore, building tasks will vary based upon location. Teams attend orientation with our building partners on the first workday, where they receive job assignments for the week and in-depth safety training.

SAA will provide each student 40 hours of community service for volunteering during the SAA trip. Students engage with community leaders from different backgrounds and build homes in and around New Orleans.

**Trip Teams:** Each student will be placed on a team after being invited to attend one of the

2024 immersion trips. These teams will travel together throughout the entire trip. Each unit has at least one Adult Team Lead "Coach" who mentors their team and drives the van. All students will meet their Adult Team Lead at the

last meeting before the trip.

SAA provides educational events and activities during their trip to help volunteers learn about the South and its unique and diverse cultures.

**Accommodations:** New Orleans: St. Jude Community Center, Camp Hope, Camp Restore, or a

similar facility. Montgomery: Hotel accommodations.

**Food:** Most meals are provided by our housing partners and are included in the cost

of the trip. As part of experiencing the local culture, the teams will go out for

meals during the trip.

**Cost:** The cost for the 2024 Shirts Across America Immersion Trip is **\$2,175** per

volunteer. It covers airfare, ground transportation, building partner fees, housing, most meals, museum visits, and other cultural activities. Payments

made towards the volunteer's trip are non-refundable.

Need based partial scholarships are available on a limited basis. When applying

please indicate your need on your application.

volunteers to be leaders. **There will be two mandatory meetings prior to each trip.** The first meeting, held on Tuesday, November 7th at **Kane Hall** on the University of Washington campus, is an educational meeting to give students and parents additional context for SAA and our immersion trips. The second meeting, held closer to the date of the trip, provides students and
